Medical Consent, Photo Permission and Liability Waiver

Parental permission must be secured for participants who are under 18 years of age. I am aware in signing this document that certain risks and dangers exist in the activities in which my child or I may be participating. I acknowledge that while at Black Hawk County Conservation staff will make every reasonable effort to teach my child or me proper safety and minimize exposure to known risks, all dangers associated with these activities cannot be foreseen. These risks may include, but are not limited to, the loss or damage of personal property, injury or fatality due to inclement weather, slipping, falling, insect bites, falling objects, immersion in cold water, hyperthermia (heat exposure) hypothermia (cold exposure) or suffering any type of accident or illness in remote areas without, immediate access to medical facilities, or while traveling to or from the activity sites. I have a personal responsibility to make sure my child and I understand and follow the safety standards, guidelines and procedures established by the BHCC staff. Furthermore, I give my consent to BHCC staff or other medical personnel to treat my child in an emergency.
